

OVERVIEW

This stomp board is specifically tailored for effects that need a bit of extra shielding on the signal lines. It's particularly well suited to valve effects and high gain stuff. We recommend it for use with the STM800 project.

Gotta throw out props to Josh of 1776 Effects who was the first to use this switching method in DIY. So if you need a board for a regular effect, head on over there and snag an OptoTron.

SHIELDED WIRE




